The C.R. Smith Museum preserves the history of American Airlines and interprets the air transportation industry. Through its activities, the museum serves active and retired and interested members of the general public. Because of the museum's commitment to education, its exhibits stress hands-on learning through hands-on displays. The museum collects artifacts and archival materials that are suitable for its educational and exhibit programs.

About

Since 1993, the C. R. Smith Museum has offered a dynamic learning environment in which exhibitions and education programs excite and engage visitors of all ages, abilities and socio-economic status. The Museum serves school children and teens, families and life-long learners through its educational programs. These include using its collections, Eagle Aviation Camps, field trip visits by local schools and community groups, *Saturday at the Smith* weekend family programs, outreach programs, *Flight Science Saturdays* design challenges, and special exhibitions focused on STEM.



Over the last 3 years, the Museum has served growing number of children through its education programs. Last year alone, 17,904 children primarily from the Dallas/Fort Worth region benefited from one of the Museum's programs. Many of these children benefited from a grant program which allows Title 1 (percentage of students on free or reduced lunch) schools to either visit the Museum or request outreach programs free of cost.

The Museum also has a large collection of artifacts placed on permanent display as well as hosts various traveling exhibits throughout the year.
