Parents & Guardians

- Scholarships are provided by generous donors and sponsors. The number of scholarships available each year depends on donations received.
- In order to be eligible for a scholarship, children and teens who apply must meet certain criteria:
 - ✓ Campers must be entering grades 3-10 in September 2024.
 - ✓ Campers must have an interest in participating in our camp program.
 - ✓ Campers must be receiving free/reduced lunch and/or parents/guardians must be able to demonstrate financial assistance need.
 - ✓ Campers must have transportation to and from the Museum during camp.
 - ✓ Campers must attend all 5 days of camp (excludes illness and emergencies, of course).
 - ✓ Parents and guardians must agree to sign a photo release and a liability waiver for their camper.
- Regular camp hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Extended hours are offered to scholarship recipients at no cost. Extended camp hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- All campers must be picked up by 5:00 p.m. without exception.
- Scholarship recipients will receive a camp T-shirt, and swag items to take home.
- Campers must bring a bagged lunch each day. Camp will provide snacks.
- During or after your child's camp experience, camp team members may reach out to you
 to get your permission to share your child's success story to help raise funds for additional
 deserving campers. Participation is encouraged, but not mandatory.
- Applications will be reviewed, prioritized, and camp management will be contacting selected applicants prior to camp for additional paperwork. Application does not, unfortunately, guarantee a spot.
